

# Fatal Attractor

**HOOK:** #10 dry **THREAD:** 6/0 black. 6/0 red (for the head - optional) **TAIL:** Red Krystal Flash  
**BODY:** Prism Dubbing in Olive **HAIR:** Elk Hair **WING:** Calf body or in this case, white floating yarn  
**HACKLE:** Grizzly Saddle

Step 1: Place thread on the top 1/3 part of the hook.



Step 2: Tie in the wing (length of the wing should be one and half times the hook gap).



Step 3: Tie down the wing material in back and in front.



Step 4: After tying down the wing material, divide it into two halves. Wrap the thread in several figure- eight formation between the two sides, then wrap the thread up each side.



Step 5: Tie in Red Krystal Flash for the tail.



Step 6: Add dubbing for the body.



Step 7: Continue dubbing right up to the wing post leaving some room to tie in the hair.



Step 8: Tie in Elk hair.



Step 9: Trim the Elk hair.



Step 10: Tie in the Grizzly Hackle.



Step 11: I am very generous with the hackle - I wrap it 5 times behind the wing post, and 3 times in front. After I whip finish the thread, I tie in a red thread to create a small head behind the hook eye. This is optional.
